Parent Information Guide

ABNC will be adhering to the Health Protocols set forth by the CDC, Gov. Abbott's Open Texas Plan and the American Camp Association concerning the COVID-19.

If your child or a family member is feeling ill or exhibiting symptoms, PLEASE stay home.

ABNC staff will be implementing the following guidelines:

1. Designated area in parking lot for check in and out by ABNC Staff. Parents will remain in their vehicles; they may not escort the child.
2. Maximum group size is 10.
3. Groups will not interact with each other, one counselor per group.
4. Each child will receive an orientation on safety and hygiene practices concerning COVID-19. Discussions will be age appropriately tailored.
5. Kids will need to bring their own: hand sanitizer, mask, bug spray, sunscreen, water bottles, snacks, lunch if staying all day and a change of clothes.
6. All equipment will be cleaned after each use.
7. ABNC will provide handwashing stations with soap and running water; (ABNC staff will turn spigots on and off).
8. Each group has a designated classroom space for storage of supplies and placement of backpacks.
9. Staff will ensure areas are frequently sanitized.
10. 90% of activities will be held outdoors.
11. Demonstrations will be conducted outside
12. Isolation area in classroom 2 in the Albemarle Education Building.
13. Masks are required.
14. Social Distancing is mandatory.
